## Da Vinci in Da Orem



If you thought you couldn't see the Mona Lisa in Utah, look again.

The Woodbury Art Museum is featuring the Da Vinci Experience, an international traveling exhibition based on the work of Leonardo Da Vinci. Straight from Italy, this exhibit is the only one of its kind in America and includes models and paintings that have been re-created using Leonardo's original notebook designs.

Museum director Marcus Vincent calls Leonardo the "epitome of the Renaissance man. He was good at everything," he says. Da Vinci — an artist, inventor and philosopher — was doing things others wouldn't discover for hundreds of years.

The exhibit at the Woodbury Art Museum shows the many facets of Leonardo's work. Replicas of many of his famous paintings are included, such as "Last Supper" and "Lady with the Ermine."

Visitors can see his early attempts at flight in gliders hanging from the ceiling, his first explorations with water in his underwater breathing and flotation devices, and his innovation with war craft in his tanks. Some of the models, like the bicycle chain, mechanical devices and room of mirrors, are available to handle.

Marcus hopes the exhibit will "inspire people to realize all of the beautiful things around. There is so much in life to be infused with, just like Da Vinci was," he says.

The Da Vinci Experience will be at the Woodbury Museum — located on the second floor of the southeast corner of University Mall — through Oct. 4.

Admission is \$14 for adults, \$11 for seniors, \$6 for students and \$28 for families. Group rates and other discounts are available. Hours are 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Friday, and noon to 5 p.m. Saturday.
